

Amigurumi Owl



Finished Size

Approximately 4 inches tall
Size depends on your yarn choice

Supplies

Size G (4.0mm) crochet hook
Worsted weight yarn in colors brown and light brown
Blue and black embroidery floss
Small piece of white felt
One piece of brown pipe cleaner
Safety eyes
Embroidery needle
Tapestry needle
Stuffing

Body

Using brown yarn

Chain 2

Rd 1: 6 sc in second chain from hook (6)

Rd 2: 2 sc in each sc around (12)

Rd 3: sc in next sc, inc in next sc around (18)

Rd 4: sc in next 2 sc, inc in next sc around (24)

Rd 5: sc in next 3 sc, inc in next sc around (30)

Rds 6-9: sc in each sc around (30)

Rd 10: sc in next 3 sc, dec over next 2 sc around (24)

Rd 11: sc in each sc around (24)

Rd 12: sc in next 2 sc, dec over next 2 sc around (18)

Rd 13: sc in next sc, dec over next 2 sc around (12)

Cut 2 circles out of the white felt. Make a small hole in each piece of felt. Push safety eyes through hole.

Place eyes on owl according to picture. Sew wings onto the side of owl.

Rds 14-15: sc in each sc around (12)

Rd 16: dec over next 2 sc around (6)

Slip stitch to join and bind off. Sew opening close. Weave in loose ends.



Wings (make 2)

Using light brown yarn

Chain 2

Rd 1: 6 sc in second chain from hook (6)

Rd 2: 2 sc in each sc around (12)

Rd 3: sc in next sc, inc in next sc around (18)

Slip stitch to bind off. Leave a long tail to sew to body.

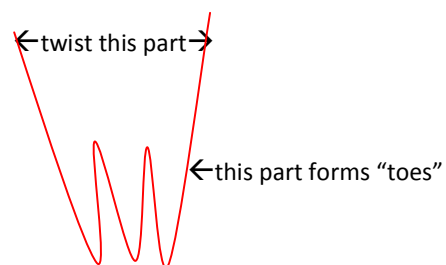


Finishing

Using blue thread, sew several "V" shapes to form feathers. With black embroidery floss stitch a triangular mouth. ▼

Legs

Cut pipe cleaner in half. Shape pipe according to the picture to form feet. Twist straight part together to form legs. Stick top portion of legs into bottom of owl.



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
